Dear colleague:

In the February 15 issue of the Columbia Union Visitor there appeared an announcement requesting suggestive illustrative materials for an exhibit at the next General Conference session in New Orleans.

For some years, I was associated with Elder R. A. Anderson and it was one of my special assignments to create evangelistic illustrations. After I became a Pastor on my own I continued to use and create various illustrations and prophetic beasts.

Elder R. A. Anderson developed a unique method of life-size cut-outs painted in perspective which were displayed with a sea scene that was most effective. While he was in the ministerial department of the General Conference I was loaned by the Potomac Conference to head up an evangelistic lab above the old Review and Herald Cafeteria whose purpose was to perfect and develop and create prophetic charts and illustrations for all our major doctrines. Also a life-size set of 3-ply sanctuary furniture cut-outs was a popular item.

I'm sending some photo copies of some of these items which I still possess as suggestions for your display. Please keep in mind they are in full color and life size. In addition we have a High Priest Robe that is most colorful and effective. Some of these items were written up in the Ministry years ago.

Elder Anderson, I believe is now living in Loma Linda and I'm sure he could explain these items better than I can because he was the founder of this system of evangelic illustrations.
